

Code of Conduct

The undersigned athlete agrees to abide by the standards outlined below in addition to those established at the team function or competition. Any additional guidelines regarding conduct will be presented to the entire group at the function or competition.

- Curfews established by the coaching staff or chaperones will be adhered to each day of the team function or competition.
- All swimmers are required to attend all team meetings, team functions, or meet sessions unless excused by the head coach or head chaperone.
- The possession or use of alcohol, tobacco or any non-prescribed drug is prohibited.
- All athletes are expected to follow the directions of the coaching staff and chaperones.
- Improper or destructive behavior will not be tolerated. Every effort should be made to avoid “guilt by association” with such activities.
 - Swimmer will be responsible for any damage expense.
- Failure to comply with the Code of Conduct may result in, but not necessarily be limited to, either or both of the following actions:
 - The swimmer will be scratched from the remainder of the meet or separated from the team function.
 - The swimmer will be sent home at the parent’s expense or must be picked up by the parent.
- Upon notification of any violation of the Code of Conduct, a review committee, consisting of the coaching staff and/or chaperones, shall promptly investigate the circumstances of the violation, shall notify the individual(s) charged of a time for a hearing, and shall conduct an informal hearing. The review committee shall then promptly determine what disciplinary action, if any, shall be taken.
